The program provides a meaningful way for people, nonprofit organizations, government organizations and companies to honor the legacy of a loved one, a special milestone, or commemorative event with a bench in one of the City's green spaces or parks.

BENCHES

Within your preferred park, a brand new bench will be installed with a plaque in one of the City's beautiful green spaces or parks. Please submit your proposed plaque inscription for approval on the next page. The commemorative benches are 6 feet long, UV and moisture resistant and have an estimated 15-year lifetime.

COST

Individuals, families and non-profit organizations: \$1,700

Corporate Rate: \$3,500

The cost of the commemorative bench is tax deductible.

Pricing includes the bench, installation and the plague.
